Care House to build new center

Care House of Oakland County plans to break ground on a \$4 million, 14,000-square-foot new home in Pontiac this April.

The organization, which serves abused and neglected children, has raised just over \$2 million of the project's estimated cost.

It plans to build on land it recently acquired on Woodward Avenue, just north of its current building, on the west side of Woodward on the former site of Ducky's Bar.

Care House said in a release that it has hired a joint venture of R.B. Construction Co. and Roncelli Inc., both of Sterling Heights, to work as general contractor on the project.

It hopes to move into the new building in the spring of 2011.
