**Circle of Friends** is one of the most important and well attended events in support of CARE House and the nearly 8,000 children and families we serve each year. It's a special day where the community comes together to show their support and raise funds for the thousands of children who need help to prevent abuse or gain healing intervention and treatment after experiencing abuse. 300 people from Oakland County attend the event in order to hear stories that are often kept quiet.

CARE House of Oakland County is an advocate for the safety of all children, and a leading resource in the prevention of child abuse, and the protection of children through intervention, treatment, education, training and research.

This year's event will feature best-selling author Theresa Flores. Theresa will share her story as a human trafficking survivor from right here in our community. As a 15-year-old girl in Birmingham, Michigan, Theresa survived two years of living hell being trafficked to men in their 20's and 30's. She was given as a reward to men in this criminal ring when they did a good job. She was an avid track runner, an older sister to three younger brothers, and looked like an all-American girl. No one, not even her parents, knew she was being trafficked for sex.

Twenty years later, Theresa is speaking out on the reality of human trafficking in the U.S. She is the author of *The Slave Across the Street*, a USA Today and Wall Street Journal best seller, and *The Sacred Bath*. Her new international book, a top seller on the UK Sunday Times list, offers a look into her escape from her traffickers and her struggle to heal.

Theresa has been invited as a guest on The 700 Club, The Today Show, and, MSNBC's *Sex Slaves — The Teen Trade*. She has also been featured on *Nightline*, *America's Most Wanted*, and *For the Record* as a sex slave survivor.
